

What is truth?

In John 18:28-40, after being betrayed and taken before the High Priest, Jesus is led from Caiaphas unto the Hall of Judgment to be questioned by Pilate before being crucified. During the inquest Pilate asks Jesus, "Art thou the King of the Jews? ...what hast thou done?" Jesus answers, in verse 37, "Thou sayest that I am a king. To this end was I born, and for this cause came I into the world, that I should bear witness unto the truth. Every one that is of the truth heareth my voice." Pilot responds, "What is truth?"

Indeed, what is truth?


For thousands of years truth was considered something that is objective and verifiable. It may be something as objective and verifiable as 1+1=2. For instance, if I pick an apple from the tree and put it in a basket and then pick another apple and put it in the basket as well, I can look into the basket and count one, two apples. Since the numbers are not subjective but objective, I can verify that 1+1=2. The number of apples in the basket does not depend on how many apples I feel like I picked or wish that I picked, it depends on how many I actually picked. That is an objective and verifiable truth.

In addition, truth is knowable and experiential. For instance, if someone tells me not to put my hand on a hot stove because it will burn, I can say that I don't believe that is true, that it is just your opinion, and put my hand on a hot stove. When I do, I will experience a burning sensation in my hand that will, hopefully, quickly change my opinion and help me to determine that what you said about putting my hand on a hot stove is indeed true. I now know it is true because I have experientially proved it to be true. That is a knowable and experiential truth.

Truth is also self-evident. The universe, for example, exists. We know that the universe exists because we exist. If the universe did not exist then we would not exist. No universe, no us. That is a self-evident truth.

Another aspect of truth is that it is logical; it makes sense. Consider the following statement: "Truth does not exist." The problem with that statement is that it does not make sense. If the statement were true then it would not be true because it purports to be a truth, which, if true, would mean that the statement violates its own assertion that truth does not exist. "Truth exists," however, is a logical statement. It makes sense. If the statement is true then truth exists and the statement is true. That is a logical truth.

A Fire in my Heart



*"My grandfather was a headhunter. But by God's grace, today I am a heart-hunter."
Rochunga Pudaite (1927-2015)*

Determined to see more of the village won for Christ, little Ro set out and began witnessing to the renowned 'wild' people of the Teisieng village in Manipur, India. With a heart full of prayer and fierce determination, Ro went to the first home. The man wanted nothing to do with the 'dead man Jesus'. Most Christians would have walked away downhearted, but a little boy with a fire in his heart was not so easily deterred. He marched to the next house; his hands clenched in determination. Around a fire, three men sat, and to Ro, they were like three giants needing to be felled. Standing silent for a moment, he gathered his courage and asked permission to proclaim the name of Jesus. "WHERE IS MY DAO?" a man shouted as he sprang to his feet.

Ro's eyes widened as he realized what was happening. A dao was a knife used by mountain people for generations for many things, but one use was head hunting. Ro turned and ran out of the house and down the road. He heard someone calling to him asking him to wait, but he dared not stop, lest he be killed. But his short legs were no

match for a grown man and he was soon overtaken. "Someone from another village has been coming around and telling me about Jesus, and I wish to hear more. Come with me and tell me about Jesus," the man begged him.

Ro feared this was some sort of trap, but he trusted that the Lord would go with him. For an hour he spoke the name of Jesus to the man, who eventually said these words, "I want to give my name to Jesus." Ro knew that this was the real thing; the man was giving himself completely to the Lord. He was the first Christian, the first follower of Jesus, in this so-called wild village. Rochunga's heart was filled with joy and rejoicing. He had led his first soul to the Lord.

God took this young man with a heart for the Hmar people of India and used him to translate the Bible into their language. Rochunga Pudaite came from a village of former headhunters and let the Lord use him in a way that no one thought possible. God is a God of extremes; He can use the least of the least for His honor and glory.

What is truth?

These aspects of truth are indicated by the origins of the word. According to the Online Etymology Dictionary (<https://www.etymonline.com/>), our English word, truth, comes from the Old English words *triewð* (West Saxon) and *treowð* (Mercian), meaning "faith, faithfulness, fidelity, loyalty; veracity, quality of being true; pledge, covenant". They, in turn, are from the Germanic word *trouwitho* and the Proto-Germanic word *truwaz*, meaning "having or characterized by good faith".

Unfortunately, truth is under attack today. Truth is being redefined as a construct of not just society but of various minority and identity groups. No longer fixed to actual facts and reality, truth is now considered fluid, subjective, and an expression of group identity, sensitivities, and opinions.

For instance, Danish philosopher Søren Kierkegaard once stated:

"Truth always rests with the minority, and the minority is always stronger than the majority, because the minority is generally formed by those who really have an opinion, while the strength of a majority is illusory, formed by the gangs who have no opinion—and who, therefore, in the next instant (when it is evident that the minority is the stronger) assume its opinion... while truth again reverts to a new minority."

Now, to the philosophers, this is an attractive definition of truth. It allows them to opine, pontificate, and philosophize all kinds of intellectual, yet ultimately meaningless, arguments about truth. To those who want to reject and redefine truth, however, Kierkegaard's concept of truth allows them to deny reality and develop a worldview based on the fluid, subjective expressions of group identity, sensitivities, and opinion. Or, to put it another way, it allows them to reject reality (actual truth) with fantasy (made up truth).

Rejection of reality is a hallmark of postmodernism. In fact, Gene Edward Veith, Jr., wrote in *Postmodern times: a Christian guide to contemporary thought and culture* (1994):

"In postmodernism, the intellect is replaced by will, reason by emotion, and morality by relativism. Reality is nothing more than a social construct; truth equals power. Your identity comes from a group. Postmodernism is char-

SPEAKING OUT AT THE STATEHOUSE



There is a move afoot in Ohio to remove the teaching of America's founding documents.

Pastor Davis joined with several other conservative and faith leaders from across the state to give testimony in opposition to House Bill 73 before the House Primary and Secondary Education Commission on Tuesday, May 18. By representing

our church in Columbus, Pastor Davis has given our church, as small as it is, an opportunity to have a much greater influence on state legislation that directly affects our freedom than you might normally expect. (You can read his testimony on page 4.)

Currently, Ohio law mandates teaching 1/2 credit hour of American History and 1/2 credit hour of American Government with mandatory testing. Included in this instruction schools are required to cover The Declaration of Independence, The United States Constitution, The Northwest Ordinance, The Ohio Constitution, The Federalist Papers, and the Ant-Federalist Papers. Ohio House Bill 73 would remove the mandatory testing. The bill itself does not remove the teaching, but by removing the testing requirement, it will deemphasize the teaching of America's founding documents.

Consequently, teachers pressed for time will lessen the time they spend on these documents in favor of more pressing matters. Leftist teacher's unions understand this. They want to take the time devoted to the great ideas encapsulated in America's founding documents and replace it with the socialist/Marxist indoctrination found in the 1619 Project, Critical Race Theory, and other leftist, "woke" curriculum. Removing the testing mandate, via HB 73, is just a stepping stone to removing the teaching of America's founding documents and replacing them with revisionist, socialist propaganda. Besides, it is hard to teach students that the Revolutionary War was fought to perpetuate slavery in America when they find out that the same people who fought in the War insisted that the Northwest Ordinance, which was written at the same time as the U.S. Constitution, would ban slavery in the Northwest Territories.

Now is the time for Ohioans to stand up against the left and contact your State Representative and tell him or her that you oppose Ohio House Bill 73. On Tuesday, May 18, I joined with a number of other concerned citizens to speak against HB 73 at the Ohio Primary and Secondary Education Committee hearing. During the hearing, a number of representatives remarked that they were getting numerous phone calls about HB 73. Several actually complained about it. So, don't give up, you are being heard! †

For the Record

The Palestinians rejected a state of their own five times:

Rejection No. 1: In 1937, the British Peel Commission offered the Arabs 80% of the geographical area known as Palestine. The Jews were offered 20%. The Arabs rejected it.

Rejection No. 2: In 1947, the Arabs rejected the United Nations partition plan.

Rejection No. 3: In 1967, in the course of defeating the attempt by Egypt, Syria and Jordan to destroy Israel, Israel conquered the West Bank from Jordan, Gaza from Egypt and the Golan Heights from Syria. Most Israelis had no interest in retaining Gaza or almost any part of the West Bank except for East Jerusalem, the Jewish city in which Jews have lived for 3,000 years, from 1,400 years before Muhammad

acterized by fragmentation, indeterminacy, and a distrust of all universalizing (worldviews) and power structures (the establishment). It is a worldview that denies all worldviews (“stories”). In a nutshell, postmodernism says there are no universal truths valid for all people. Instead, individuals are locked into the limited perspective of their own race, gender or ethnic group. It is Nietzsche in full bloom.”

The postmodern view of reality and truth has paved the way for the rise of woke-ism. Woke-ism rejects reason, logic, and objective truth for emotion, identity, and subjective opinion for a new worldview based on the enlightened teachings of the group. The group, in this case, being the enlightened postmodern progressives who have freed themselves from the chains of traditional values and objective reality. Being woke means, according to the New Discourses Commentary (<https://newdiscourses.com/tftw-woke-wokeness/>):

“... having awakened to having a particular type of ‘critical consciousness,’ as these are understood within Critical Social Justice. To first approximation, being woke means viewing society through various critical lenses, as defined by various critical theories bent in service of an ideology most people currently call ‘Social Justice.’ That is, being woke means having taken on the worldview of Critical Social Justice, which sees the world only in terms of unjust power dynamics and the need to dismantle problematic systems. That is, it means having adopted Theory and the worldview it conceptualizes.”

Oh, and if you do not understand the leftist jargon in that statement, then you are not woke.

Woke-ism is fast becoming the religion of the Left. Tripp Parker in his article, *The New Religion Of The Woke Left Is A Faith Without Atonement* (<https://thefederalist.com/2020/06/30/new-religion-woke-left-faith-without-atonement/>), wrote:

“So, how is the Woke Left similar to a religion? Well, even without a supernatural element, it has all the

remain in the tribe with myths that aren’t subjected to normal academic scrutiny (the 1619 Project); it has sacred texts (White Fragility), its idea of original sin (being born white and/or male), rituals (including self-flagellation), symbols, heretics (hello, JK Rowling), and de facto priests and prophets to enlighten and then initiate us into this new religion. All will be shown a new way of viewing everything about the world, and we must adopt this without caveats or questions.”

Dissent is not allowed. Questioning and free thinking is heretical. Blind faith and absolute adherence to woke-ness is demanded.



Of course, the ultimate problem with woke-ism is not merely its rejection of objective reality and traditional values for the fantasy worldview of the progressive, postmodern Left. It is the rejection of biblical truth and the Judeo-Christian worldview for humanistic philosophy and man-centered ideology. It makes man, or rather the group, the

sole arbitrator of truth, rather than God and His Word. Consequently, it is a rejection of God Himself.

Consider, then, what the Bible has to say about truth. In John 14:6, Jesus says, “...I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by me.” If we believe that Jesus is God manifest in the flesh, as the Bible claims, then this must be a true statement because the Bible also says, in Titus 1:2, “In hope of eternal life, which God, that cannot lie, promised before the world began”.

So, if Jesus Christ’s claim to be “truth” in John 14:6 is true, then it follows that His words are true. This logical, reasonable conclusion is actually stated in John 17:17, where Jesus says, “Sanctify them through thy truth: thy word is truth.” Which brings up another kind of truth: revealed truth.

Revealed truth is found in the words of the God who cannot lie. These words of truth, given by inspiration of God (2 Timothy 3:16) and preserved by the Lord Himself (Psalm 12:6-7) are sure words (2 Peter 1:19). They constitute the Word of God, otherwise known as the Bible; the “word of truth” (2 Timothy 2:15).

The Word of God is also described as the word of life in Philippians 2:16 and elsewhere in the Scriptures. As such it has another unique characteristic that separates

was born. The Palestinians, as the Arabs of Palestine came to be known, and all the Arab states rejected partition and peace.

Rejection No. 4: In 2000, at Camp David, Israeli Prime Minister Ehud Barak offered Palestinian leader Yasser Arafat a Palestinian state in all of Gaza and 94% of the West Bank *with East Jerusalem as its capital*. But Arafat rejected the offer. In the words of U.S. President Bill Clinton, Arafat was ‘here 14 days and said no to everything.’

Rejection No. 5: In 2008, Israel tried again. Prime Minister Ehud Olmert went even further than Ehud Barak had, expanding the peace offer to include additional land to sweeten the deal. The Palestinians said no, again.

The reason for all these Palestinian/Arab rejections of a state of their own was that it meant a Jewish state in the Middle East still existed.

it from the words of men. It brings life, eternal life, to those who heed its truths. In fact, Peter said to Jesus in John 6:68, "...Lord, to whom shall we go? thou hast the words of eternal life." He later wrote in 1 Peter 1:23, "Being born again, not of corruptible seed, but of incorruptible, by the word of God, which liveth and abideth for ever."

Rejection of truth, God's truth, brought humanity into the bondage of sin and death. God revealed His truth to Adam in the Garden of Eden when He told Adam not to eat from the tree of the knowledge of good and evil. Nevertheless, after Satan beguiled Eve into eating the forbidden fruit, Adam rejected the objective reality of God's words for his own subjective thoughts and emotions. The result? "Wherefore, as by one man sin entered into the world, and death by sin; and so death passed upon all men, for that all have sinned (Romans 5:12)".

Opponent Testimony on House Bill 73 Before the Ohio House Primary and Secondary Education Committee on 16 May 2021

Good afternoon Chairwoman Manning, Vice-Chair Bird, Ranking Member Robinson, and Committee Members. My name is Alfred Davis. I am the pastor of the Bible Baptist Church in Richfield, Ohio, and a board member of the Ohio Christian Alliance. Thank you for the opportunity to give testimony in opposition of House Bill 73, Regards educational testing, assessment, and retention.

Our Founding Fathers were very concerned about the prospect of future generations losing sight of the reasons for which they broke away from England in order to form a new and independent country. They believed strongly that knowledge and understanding of our history is vitally important to the preservation of a free and self-governing Republic. Thomas Jefferson, for example, in a letter to William Charles Jarvis, September 28, 1820, said:

"I know no safe depository of the ultimate powers of the society but the people themselves; and if we think them not enlightened enough to exercise their control with a wholesome discretion, the remedy is not to take it from them, but to inform their discretion by education. This is the true corrective of abuses of constitutional power."

Currently, thanks to the passage of Senate Bill 165, the Founding of America Documents Curriculum, in the 129th General Assembly in 2012, Ohio public schools are required to educate and test students in grades 8-12 regarding the history and importance of our Founding Documents, namely The U.S. Constitution, The Bill of Rights, The Northwest Ordinance, The Declaration of Independence, The Ohio Constitution, the Federalist Papers, and the Anti-Federalist Papers.

Knowledge and understanding of these foundational documents are essential to build future generations of Ohioans who are properly prepared and able to function as free citizens, citizens who can safeguard the freedoms and rights secured for us by

the Founding Fathers, citizens that understand who we are and what our country stands for. After all, as historian David McCullough observed, "History is who we are and why we are the way we are."


House Bill 73 may have good intentions, but it will undo the good that Senate Bill 165 has done. Thanks to the curriculum and testing mandated by Senate Bill 165, Ohio high school students have, in recent years, achieved higher proficiency test rates in American History and American Government than their counterparts in other states. However, by eliminating the end-of-course exams for American Government and American History, House Bill 73 has the potential to reverse these successes by reducing the amount of time spent in the classroom teaching Ohio's students the importance of the great ideas and values that our founding documents encapsulate. Without the testing requirements, teachers pressed for time will gradually limit and possibly even eliminate the teaching of these important documents. Keeping the testing requirements will help to ensure that teachers spend the time necessary

to ensure that Ohio's students are properly educated and prepared to function as free citizens and transmit these important ideas and values to future generations.

Therefore, I respectfully urge the Members of the Ohio House Primary and Secondary Education Committee to defeat House Bill 73, Regards educational testing, assessment, and retention, to ensure that Ohio's students continue to be taught the value of our country and state's founding documents.
