

Obstacles to Global Governance

For many years, since the 1970's at least, I have been reading about plans being readied for a one world government. The coming world government is always just around the corner, imminent, almost here, or just waiting on one more thing, yet it never quite happened. No matter how hard the globalists scheme and manipulate, something always seems to hamper their efforts and prevent their plans from coming to fruition.

After World War One, President Woodrow Wilson and other world leaders pushed the concept of a League of Nations. The globalists saw this as a means to bring the various countries of the world together in an international organization, thus paving the way for an eventual world government. Unfortunately for the globalists, the League of Nations failed.

The League of Nations failed largely because the United States did not become a part of it. Despite President Wilson's best efforts, and several votes, the Senate failed to ratify Treaty of Versailles. The Treaty, in addition to ending World War I, provided for a new inter-

national world body called the League of Nations. Failure to secure the support of the United States can largely be attributed to the concerns of isolationists and nationalists, led by Senate Majority Leader Henry Cabot Lodge (R-Mass.), chairman of the Foreign Relations Committee, and Sen. William Borah (R-Neb.), leader of a group known as the "Irreconcilables", who feared that League of Nations would weaken American sovereignty and subordinate United States interests to those of the internationalists. The fact that President Wilson suffered a stroke after cutting short a 27-day train trip where he planned to sell the American people on the League of Nations did not help either.

The next major attempt to further the cause of world government was spurred on by World War Two. Frustrated with the weaknesses and limitations of the Leagues of Nations and building on the ashes of WWII, world leaders came together to form the United Nations. Knowing that the support and participation of the United States would be crucial, they located the United Nations headquarters in New York City rather than in Europe. However, attempts to morph the United Nations into a true world governing body have consistently been

hindered by the reluctance of the United States to subordinate its national sovereignty and the Constitutional rights of its citizens to the world body.

Over time, however, the globalists have made great strides in overcoming the opposition of the United States to world government. The efforts of progressives, technocrats, socialists, and various statist oriented globalists have achieved tremendous influence, if not outright control, over educational institutions, religious organizations, charitable funds, media and entertainment organizations, even major political parties. Yet still, America has proved to be a consistent obstacle to world government.

Little by little, though, the globalists have been leading, cajoling, and seducing the American people down the path to surrender. Finally, with the election of President Barak Obama and his promise to "Fundamentally change America" the globalists seemed almost ready to achieve their goals. President Obama's Administration set the wheels in motion and the seemingly inevitable election of Hillary Clinton to the office of President was sure to bring about America's final submission to the globalist agenda. But, once again, their plans were foiled as the Presidency was snatched away from them at the last minute by the most unlikely of candidates, Donald Trump.

What happened?

Well, around the country, Christians began praying. Franklin Graham led prayer rallies in the capitals of all fifty states. He did not advocate for or endorse any particular candidate. Instead, he reminded Christians of what God said in 2 Chronicles 7:14: "If my people, which are called by my name, shall humble themselves, and pray, and seek my face, and turn from their wicked ways; then will I hear from heaven, and will forgive their sin, and will heal their land." He then implored Christians to go to God in prayer, confessing their sins and the sins of their communities, states, and country.

Then, on the night of the election, November 8, 2016, a large Christian gathering in Jerusalem called any Americans present to come to the front. It was around 8:00 or 9:00 p.m. on the east coast of America when they began to pray for the American presidential elections. About the same time, former con-

Samoan Bible Preserved, Digitized, Online!

Shortly after arriving as missionaries in the Samoan Islands in 1993, Pastor Alfred and Mrs. Kimberly Davis learned that there were two Bible translations available in the Samoan language. The oldest was a translation put together in the 1800's. It was based on the Textus Receptus and the King James Bible. The second was produced in the mid Twentieth Century. It was based on the less reliable Critical Text.

Unfortunately, the older Samoan Bible was in danger of becoming extinct. The plates to print it were not available and those who had it were not printing any more. If not for the Lord's intervention, it would have soon disappeared, only to be replaced by the inferior, newer Samoan Bible.

Pastor and Mrs. Davis, along with others prayed that God would rescue the old Samoan Bible (OSB). Some years later those prayers were answered when Missionaries Jim and Emi Civalé led of the Lord to reprint the OSB.

The Civalés, who came to Christ during the during the ministry of Pastor and Mrs. Davis and Rev. John and Robin Yingling in American Samoa, first tried to obtain the OSB printing plates. However, when that was not possible, they soon came up with an audacious plan. They decided to scan each page of the OSB, farm out portions of the copies via email to Bible believing Christians around the world. The Believers were asked to print out the pages they received, hand type them into a Word document, and then send the new document



back to Bro. Civalé.

Over time, the work was carried out by Bible loving Christians burdened to see the OSB preserved. Even Pastor Davis and his daughter, Anna, worked on some of the pages. Also, several errors in the original OSB were found and corrected.

Eventually, the job was done. The OSB was copied, digitized, and soon being printed and distributed throughout the Samoan Islands. Even better, it is now available online.

gresswoman Michelle Bauchmann and Daystar Christian TV network founders, Marcus and Joni Lamb, urged Christians across the country to pray for the election as well. Shortly after that, a shift in the election results began to be seen. Confidence in Hillary Clinton's certain win began to give way to concern until, finally, it was apparent that Donald Trump had done the impossible and won the election for President of the United States of America!

Once again, attempts to further the globalists goal of world government ended in failure.

Looking back, it is easy to see why the globalists hate the United States and President Trump. America, more than any other county, has prevented them from achieving their goals. Then, just as America seemed about to fall into their clutches, President Donald Trump came along and upended their plans once more. No wonder they hate him so much! But President Trump and America are not the real reason why the globalists have failed. The real reason is much greater, and it has to do with the Christians who have been praying for President Trump and America.

Here is what I mean. In 2 Thessalonians 2:1-7, Paul writes:

- (1) *Now we beseech you, brethren, by the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ, and by our gathering together unto him,*
- (2) *That ye be not soon shaken in mind, or be troubled, neither by spirit, nor by word, nor by letter as from us, as that the day of Christ is at hand.*
- (3) *Let no man deceive you by any means: for that day shall not come, except there come a falling away first, and that man of sin be revealed, the son of perdition;*
- (4) *Who opposeth and exalteth himself above all that is called God, or that is worshipped; so that he as God sitteth in the temple of God, shewing himself that he is God.*
- (5) *Remember ye not, that, when I was yet with you, I told you these things?*(6) *And now ye know what withholdeth that he might be revealed in his time.*
- (7) *For the mystery of iniquity doth already work: only he who now letteth will let, until he be taken out of the way.*
- (8) *And then shall that Wicked be revealed...*

In this passage Paul is writing to both

warn and comfort the believers in Thessalonica regarding the rise of the Antichrist, whom Paul refers to as "that man of sin, the son of perdition." The Antichrist, also known as "the beast" in the Book of Revelation, comes to power following the catching away of the Believers out of the world and rules over the world during the Tribulation period. Just as there had been some fear in confusion among the Thessalonians regarding the second coming of Christ and the fate of those who had died, which he addressed in his first letter to them, there



was also concern about the coming of the Antichrist.

Paul starts off in the first two verses by imploring them that they, "be not soon shaken in mind, or be troubled...As that the day of Christ is at hand." In verse 3 he assures them that there must be a "falling away first" before "that man of sin be revealed." Then, in verse 4, he describes how the Antichrist will eventually attempt to take the place of God by entering into the Temple "so that he as God sitteth in the temple of God, shewing himself that he is God." In the next several verses, verses 5-8, Paul then goes on to remind the Thessalonians that they had spoken of these things previously and that the revelation of the Antichrist is actively being prevented until the appropriate time.

So, what and who are hindering the Mystery of Iniquity and the revelation of the Antichrist? The answer lies in verses six and seven.

In verse six, Paul says, "And now ye know what withholdeth that he might be revealed in his time." He is referring to something that is actively withholding or preventing the Antichrist from coming to power. It is important to note that the word translated as "withholdeth" comes from the Greek word, "katecho". The "what" that Paul refers to is specifically identified as

being that which prevents the Son of Perdition from coming to power.

Then, in verse seven, Paul writes, "For the mystery of iniquity doth already work: only he who now letteth [*katecho*] will let, until he be taken out of the way." Please note, again, the use of the Greek word, "*katecho*". Since we know that *katecho* means to withhold or prevent, the word "letteth" is clearly used in the sense of hindering and not in the sense of permitting, like in the legal phrase, "Without let or hindrance" (the word "let" in verse seven is derived from *katecho*). Also, Paul is clearly referring to a person, "he", that is now hindering the Mystery of Iniquity that is currently active in the world.

Working backwards, from verse seven, I believe the "he" that Paul refers to is the Person of the Holy Spirit. The Spirit of God began His current ministry after Jesus Christ, God the Son, ascended into heaven. A few days later, on the day of Pentecost, Luke writes in Acts 2:1-4:

And when the day of Pentecost was fully come, they were all with one accord in one place. And suddenly there came a sound from heaven as of a rushing mighty wind, and it filled all the house where they were sitting. And there appeared unto them cloven tongues like as of fire, and it sat upon each of them. And they were all filled with the Holy Ghost, and began to speak with other tongues, as the Spirit gave them utterance.

The indwelling of the Believers with the Holy Spirit was a fulfillment of the Lord's promise in Acts 1:8 to empower them for His service:

But ye shall receive power, after that the Holy Ghost is come upon you: and ye shall be witnesses unto me both in Jerusalem, and in all Judaea, and in Samaria, and unto the uttermost part of the earth.

A similar promise was given by Jesus in John 16:7-11 as well:

Nevertheless I tell you the truth; It is expedient for you that I go away: for if I go not away, the Comforter will not come unto you; but if I depart, I will send him unto you. And when he is come, he will reprove the world of sin, and of righteousness, and of judgment: Of sin, because they believe not on me; Of righteousness, because I go to my Father, and ye see me no more; Of judgment, because the prince of this world is judged.

It is evident, then, that God, through the Person of the Holy Spirit, is active in the world, hindering and holding back the work of the Mystery of Iniquity, partly by

reproving "the world of sin, and of righteousness, and of judgment" (John 16:8). He does this by working through Christians who are indwelt with the Holy Spirit at salvation.

Consequently, these Believers are evidently the "what" of verse six who are empowered by the Holy Spirit of God and used by God to prevent the Son of Perdition from coming to power. They are what Jesus referred to in Matthew 5:13-16 saying:

Ye are the salt of the earth: but if the salt have lost his savour, wherewith shall it be salted? it is thenceforth good for nothing, but to be cast out, and to be trodden under foot of men. Ye are the light of the world. A city that is set on a hill cannot be hid. Neither do men light a candle, and put it under a bushel, but on a candlestick; and it giveth light unto all that are in the house. Let your light so shine before men, that they may see your good works, and glorify your Father which is in heaven.

Salt preserves and adds flavor. Light illuminates and disinfects. This is also the role of Believers, the true born-again Christians, in the world. We are to be salt and light, retarding the spread of sin and wickedness in the world around us while bringing God's light to those in darkness and hope to those in despair. And, as such, the Holy Spirit hinders the work of the Mystery of Iniquity by working through His Believers, thereby preventing the Man of Sin from being revealed.

Understanding how God works in the world through His people helps explain the consistent failure of the globalists to achieve their dreams of a one world government. It also helps explain why the globalist despise America, President Trump, Christianity, and, ultimately, God. They hate America because America has thwarted their efforts to bring about a global government. They hate President Trump because President Trump has upended their plans subvert America. They hate Christians because Christians helped Donald Trump defeat Hillary Clinton and hinder their efforts to drive President Trump out of office. But they hate God even more because it is ultimately God who has frustrated them in their efforts to bring the world under their control.

One day, however, things will change. The Holy Spirit's present ministry will end and "...he who now letteth will let, until he be taken out of the way. And then shall that Wicked be revealed..." (2 Thes-

salonians 2:7-8). When the Holy Spirit is taken out of the way, Believers, by necessity, will be taken out of the way, too. They will be taken out of the way because the Bible says that Believers "are sealed unto the day of redemption" (Ephesians 4:30) by God "Who hath also sealed us, and given the earnest of the Spirit in our hearts" (2 Corinthians 1:22).

The way Believers are taken out of the world is described in 1 Thessalonians 4:14-17, where Paul writes:

(14) For if we believe that Jesus died and rose again, even so them also which sleep in Jesus will God bring with him.

(15) For this we say unto you by the word of the Lord, that we which are alive and remain unto the coming of the Lord shall not prevent them which are asleep.

(16) For the Lord himself shall descend from heaven with a shout, with the voice of the archangel, and with the trump of God: and the dead in Christ shall rise first:

(17) Then we which are alive and remain shall be caught up together with them in the clouds, to meet the Lord in the air: and so shall we ever be with the Lord.

In this passage Paul refers to catching away of Believers in verse 17. This catching away is what many refer to as the Rapture. It follows, then, that when the Spirit of God, who seals Believers until the day of redemption, ceases from His present ministry and taken away, the Believers are taken away with Him.

The dead in Christ, whose soul and spirit are, according to 2 Corinthians 5:8, absent from the body but present with the Lord, come with Jesus at the Rapture (1 Thessalonians 4:14) to be rejoined with their resurrected body (1 Thessalonians 4:16). Immediately following, the Believers who are alive are caught up with them to meet the Lord in the air (1 Thessalonians 4:17).

Paul elaborates on what happens at the Rapture in 1 Corinthians 15:51-53, saying:

(51) Behold, I shew you a mystery; We shall not all sleep, but we shall all be changed,

(52) In a moment, in the twinkling of an eye, at the last trump: for the trumpet shall sound, and the dead shall be raised incorruptible, and we shall be changed.

(53) For this corruptible must put on incorruption, and this mortal must put on immortality.

Following the catching away of the

Believers, the Bible presents in the Book of Revelation the revelation of the Antichrist. John, as a type of the Believers, is caught up into heaven and shown "things which must be hereafter" (Revelation 4:1) the things describe in chapters 2-3 of Revelation. The events of Revelation 4 describe a change in how God deals with the world. In chapters 2-3 we can see God ministering through churches. In chapter 4, the Believers are now removed to heaven and God begins to bring judgments upon the earth and those that have rejected His Son.

The first of those judgments involve a book with seven seals. The opening of the first seal, in Revelation 6:2 is described by John:

"And I saw, and behold a white horse: and he that sat on him had a bow; and a crown was given unto him: and he went forth conquering, and to conquer."

This is the revelation of the Antichrist, the one-world global leader also known in Scripture as the Beast, the Son of Perdition, and the Man of Sin. When he comes to power, he confirms a covenant, likely some sort of peace deal or security compact with Israel, in accordance with Daniel's prophecy in Daniel 9:27. This begins the seven-year Tribulation period, which culminates in the Battle of Armageddon and the physical return of Jesus Christ to the world as King of Kings and Lord of Lords.

Now, since the devil does not know when Jesus is going to catch away the Believers, the devil must always be prepared for the moment that he will be able to bring the Antichrist to power. Consequently, the devil is probably watching and waiting much more intently than most Christians. As he sees the day approaching, he will be stepping up his preparations, waiting until the day that the Mystery of Iniquity can be revealed and the Antichrist can be brought to the helm of a one-world government.

Until then, according to Ephesians 6:12, "...we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high places." We need to "not be weary in well doing (Galatians 6:9)" and remember, "...when these things begin to come to pass, then look up, and lift up your heads; for your redemption draweth nigh. (Luke 21:28)"✠
